PROVISIONS FOR BIDS

All bidders must submit 1 original copy.

Bids must be signed and dated with the name printed below the signature by an authorized officer or employee of the bidder.

Bidders must submit a W9 with their bid. The W9 form can be located on our website under the bids tab.

Bidders must submit a certificate of insurance and name Homer Township Highway Dept as insured with their bid.

Sealed Bid Proposals shall be marked "HTHD 2024 Roadway Program" and be accompanied by a Proposal Guarantee (in the form of a Bidder's Bond, Cashier's Check, Certified Check or Bank Draft) in the amount equal to at least five (5%) of the amount of the proposal as a guarantee that if the proposal is accepted, the Bidder will execute the Contract and file acceptable Performance and Payment Bonds within ten (10 days) of the awarded contract. Electronic bidders must scan and upload proof of a Proposal Guarantee to bids@homerhighway.com along with all other required documents.

The Township reserves the right to reject any and all bids and bidders and waive all technicalities. All proposals shall be valid for a period of sixty (60 days).

Bids must comply with the Homer Township Road District's Prevailing Wage Ordinance # HTHD-060914 and the Illinois Public Act 96-0437:

Notice Requirement under the Prevailing Wage Act

This contract calls for the construction of a "public work," within the meaning of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act. 820 ILCS 130/.01 *et seq*. ("the Act"). The Act requires contractors and subcontractors to pay laborers, workers and mechanics performing services on public works projects no less than the "prevailing rate of wages" (hourly cash wages plus fringe benefits) in the county where the work is performed. All contractors and subcontractors rendering services under this contract must comply with all requirements of the Act, *including but not limited* to, all wage, notice and record keeping duties.

The Road District will award the project to the lowest responsible bidder. The Road District reserves the right to accept or reject any bid that in its' opinion, best serves the Township's interest. Any bidder may be required to furnish evidence satisfactory to The Homer Township Highway Department that the bidder and their proposed subcontractors have sufficient means, expertise, experience and the financial ability to successfully complete the project required by The Homer Township Highway Department.

- 1. HMA Mix Design (See IDOT Spec 406 for Mix D, Class I, Type 2), and Prime Coat (See IDOT Section 406).
- 2. All HMA depths are assumed to be 4" for milling and overlay. Binder course depth to be 2.5" and surface course to be 1.5" thick.
- 3. All HMA work shall be performed with temperatures of 45 degrees F and rising and ribboned off with lathe for 24 hours during curing then opened to traffic.
- 4. Application Rates: Prime Coat 0.25 lbs/sf, Tack Coat 0.025 lbs/sf, HMA 112 lb/sy/in.
- 5. Traffic control shall follow typical IDOT Local Roads Standards for lane closures and flaggers.
- 6. All streets shall be crowned with a 1.5% cross slope.
- 7. Pavement cores indicate existing pavement sections ranging from the following depths as per the AGI Geotechnical Report:
 - 136th Avenue 5.5"-7.5" over 4"-9" stone
 - 138th Street (off Smith Road) 3.25"-4.75" over 12"-13" stone
 - 140th Street (off Smith Road) 4.75"-6.5" over 8"-9" stone
 - 147th Place 6.5"-14.5" over 0"-8.5" stone



Prevailing Wage- This contract calls for the construction of a "public work," within the meaning of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/.01 *et seq*. ("the Act"). The Act requires contractors and subcontractors to pay laborers, workers and mechanics performing services on public works projects no less than the current "prevailing rate of wages" (hourly cash wages plus amount for fringe benefits) in the county where the work is performed. The Department publishes the prevailing wage rates on its website at http://labor.illinois.gov/. The Department revises the prevailing wage rates and the contractor/subcontractor has an obligation to check the Department's web site for revisions to prevailing wage rates. For information regarding current prevailing wage rates, please refer to the Illinois Department of Labor's website. All contractors and subcontractors rendering services under this contract must comply with all requirements of the Act, *including but not limited to*, all wage requirements and notice and record keeping duties.

I, as the authorized Vendor/Contractor, do hereby certify to the best of my knowledge and belief, the submitted information is true, correct and complete. I certify that the filing of this proposal has been duly approved by the company I represent. I acknowledge that I have read and agree to comply with all requirements and understand that my proposal could be denied or rejected if compliance has not been met. I further agree to provide Homer Township Road District with a certified payroll by the 10th of the month immediately preceding the public works project (as required per Act) and understand that payment will not be issued until received.

Additional Terms & Conditions

The Road District shall pay Vendor/Contractor up to the agreed-upon, accepted amount in exchange for the Work described herein. Payment shall be rendered after the Road District's receipt of invoices following Vendor/Contractor's provision of services. The Road District's payment shall be contingent on any agreed-upon approval processes and the Road District having sufficient budget appropriation and said invoice or bill otherwise receiving approval according to law. Any and all change orders shall be subject to re-approval, rebidding, or other applicable requirements pursuant to law.

The Agreement shall commence upon the Effective Date (if so defined or else upon the last date on which the Vendor/Contractor or the Highway Commissioner executes this Agreement) and shall expire on the last day of the Road District's Fiscal Year (March 31st), unless a renewal or other terms are agreed upon in writing. The Agreement shall earlier terminate upon (i) Vendor/Contractor's failure to provide Services; (ii) Vendor/Contractor's violation or breach of any of the other terms and conditions of this Agreement, and continuation of such violation or breach for a period of ten (10) days after notice thereof, is given by Road District to Vendor/Contractor (provided that if the nature of the breach is such that it cannot be cured within said ten (10) day period, Vendor/Contractor shall be deemed to have cured same upon completion of the corrective action if within said ten (10) day period if it commences and diligently pursues such cure and thereafter completes same within such time as is reasonable under the circumstances); (iii) by the Road District upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to Vendor/Contractor; or (iv) Vendor/Contractor's bankruptcy, insolvency, assignment for the benefit of creditors, or other condition or circumstance that in the Road District's discretion places Vendor/Contractor's ability to deliver the Services during the term of this Agreement in doubt.

The waiver by Road District of any breach or default under any provisions of this Agreement shall not be deemed to constitute a waiver of such provision for any subsequent breach or default of the same or any other provision.

Vendor/Contractor agrees and acknowledges that the Vendor/Contractor, employees, and agents are, and shall remain, independent contractors throughout the term of this Agreement and are not employees or agents of the Road District. Vendor/Contractor agrees that it or its employees are not and will not become employees, agents, or officers of the Road District while this Agreement is in effect. Vendor/Contractor agrees that nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as creating any employment relationship between the Vendor/Contractor and the Road District, and thus, by operation of this Agreement, Vendor/Contractor does not acquire any rights as to Vendor/Contractor under the provisions of the Illinois Human Rights Act, the Illinois Workers' Compensation Act or any similar federal, state, or local statute or ordinance covering employees. Vendor/Contractor agrees it is not entitled to the rights or benefits afforded to the Road District's employees, including disability or unemployment insurance, workers' compensation, medical insurance, sick leave, or any other employment benefit. Vendor/Contractor further agrees that by operation of this Agreement, it has not become covered by the Road District insurance coverage and is responsible for all costs which Vendor/Contractor may incur in connection with any and all injuries suffered by Vendor/Contractor, employees or agents in performance of this Agreement. Vendor/Contractor is responsible for providing, at his own expense, disability, unemployment, and other insurance, workers' compensation, training, permits, and licenses, if any, for his employees or agents.

This Agreement shall be governed by, and its provisions construed, under Illinois law. If any provision, clause, word or designation of this Agreement is held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision, clause, word or designation shall be deemed to be excised from this Agreement and the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provisions, clause, word or designation contained herein.
